

## STUDY AND EXAM REQUIREMENT IN BIOCHEMISTRY

#### **Study requirements and checking knowledge**

Attendance of **lectures** is obligatory (see enclosed schedule of lectures) (**FOG-MA033**). Lecture will be accepted with **final exam**

During the semester, one **mid-term-exam** can be taken with successful 5,4,3 ESE result. The **Biochemical competition** will be in written form (test and assay questions) and involves theoretical and practical questions. Test questions to practice will be available on the website of the Institute. Time of the MTO: on the 11<sup>th</sup> educational week (11-15<sup>th</sup> of April), topics: blood, biomembranes, muscle, connective tissue and cell adhesion, cytoskeleton, liver, nervous system. The result of the MTO will influence the number of topics at the final exam (see table). Retake of mid-term-exam is not possible!!

- **Molecular developmental biology course** is one of the compulsory elective subjects for the students. (**FOG-MAE101**) Acceptance of this lecture will be with „evaluation“ (5 graded evaluation)
- **Biochemical Basics of Preventive Medicine** is one of the compulsory elective subjects for the students. (**FOGMAE091**) Acceptance of this lecture will be with „evaluation“ (5 graded evaluation)
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- **Biochemistry seminar II** is one of the compulsory elective subjects for the students. (**FOG-MAC111**) Acceptance of this course will be with „evaluation“ (5 graded evaluation)

#### **Exam requirements**

The students have to take an oral **final exam**. Preparation for the final exam is to be done according to the theoretical and practical topic lists. Number of topics at the final exam, see table. Students have to sign up for the exam at the ETR. Exams are on the 5 weekdays (students will be informed about any changes), the Institute can accept max. 3 students per a day. Site of the exam is the Main Educational Building (Dóm square 13, 4<sup>th</sup> floor), start is at 8 am.

Those students who did not pass the Biochemistry end semester exam, can take it again during this exam term (**Biochemistry I** as an **exam course**), before the final exam. Sign up for the final exam can be taken only in case of successful ESE. Those students who did not pass the Biochemistry end semester exam even during this summer exam term, have to start their Biochemistry studies again, and complete Biochemistry I lecture and practical courses again from September. In case of unsuccessful final exam, **Biochemistry II cannot be taken as an exam course**, students have to complete Biochemistry II lecture and practical again during the next spring term.

Repetition of exams is according to the general regulations of the Study and the Exam Requirements of the University. Exclusively repeated exam can be taken on the repeated exam week.

**Repeater students and exam course students** of this semester must visit Biochemistry II lectures and sign the present sheet. The course can be accepted in case of presence at minimum 75% of the lectures!!! Present sheet for all students of the course is possible during the semester.
